I plan to provide humanitarian aid by means of eye operations in Togo over the next several years. Eye cataracts are a major issue there, and occur in all age groups. They respond well to surgery.

Through personal contact with Father Théo in Togo, I decided to provide help in Africa together with my experienced surgery team. Togo is among the poorest nations in the world. Eye surgery can bring much needed relief to the poverty-stricken indigenous population.

I have gained experience working in developing countries, particularly in India (Gujarat) and Mexico (Acapulco). With your help, my next goal is to provide relief to people in Togo.

It all starts by establishing the foundation called "ToGo opening eyes". Please aid a good cause and support our foundation by filling out and returning the enclosed deposit slip to me.
